

**Product description:** This product is recombinant Endo- $\beta$ -N-Acetylglucosaminidase F2 (Endo S; glycosyl hydrolase family 18, EC #3.2.1.96), cloned from *Streptococcus pyogenes* and expressed in *Escherichia coli* with an N-terminal 8xHis tag. The 8xHis tag may be removed by digestion with FasTEV<sup>TM</sup> (Cat #GE0501), a TEV protease with enhanced stability and catalytic activity.

Endo S catalyzes the cleavage of *N*-linked glycans from IgG heavy chain, as illustrated below.



This product does not contain any detectable activities of proteases or other glycosidases.

**Unit definition:** One unit is defined as the amount of Endo S required to deglycosylate > 90% of 2.5  $\mu$ g of human immunoglobulin (Ig) in 1 h at 37°C in 25  $\mu$ L 1X Reaction Buffer 6 (50 mM NaOAc, 5 mM CaCl<sub>2</sub>, pH 5.5).

**Product reconstitution:** Dissolve the lyophilized Endo S in 100 μL molecular grade water to make a 25,000 units/mL (Cat #GE0801) solution in enzyme storage buffer (20 mM Tris-HCl, 50 mM NaCl, 1 mM EDTA, pH 7.5). Once reconstituted, store at 4°C for up to 7 days or -20°C for up to 3 months. Aliquoting is recommended to avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. *Cat #GE0801C includes human Ig (GC0101), a control substrate purified from human serum by Protein A affinity chromatography.* 

## **Activity assay:**

1. Mix the following components in a microfuge tube:

 $\begin{array}{ll} \text{IgG sample, e.g., human Ig (GC0101)} & 2.5~\mu\text{g} \\ 10\text{X Reaction Buffer 6 (BA1001)} & 2.5~\mu\text{L} \\ \text{Endo S (GE0801)} & 1.0\text{-}25~\text{units} \\ \text{Molecular grade water} & \text{to } 25~\mu\text{L final volume} \end{array}$ 

- 2. Incubate at 37°C for 1 h.
- 3. Analyze by SDS-PAGE mobility shift or other method to determine the extent of deglycosylation.
